- 6. Unders will be athletic shorts with a fitted shirt. Returning members may have to buy new shorts and shirts. Sample sizes of the unders and marching shoes will be available at Everything Day.
- 7. Flamingo Fundraiser suggested dates: August 8-11. Discussion about proceeds to go towards a Spring Trip. Linda Grant made a motion to designate the funds for a future trip. Susan Vahrenkamp seconded the motion.
- 8. Canopies are needed for summer band. Instead of purchasing booster canopies, we will ask for parent volunteers to lend canopies. Colleen Stearns volunteered two canopies.
- 9. Water jugs will be prepared for distribution on Saturday. We will use the label maker and a sealant to label the jugs. (Linda and Liz)
- 10. Chaperones (7) will be needed for each bus trip. Colleen Stearns will have 3 QR codes ready for Everything Day to begin recruiting volunteers. The signup genius pages are already published for away games and home game popcorn. Colleen will republish the chaperone training video and will ask for BISD volunteer application.
